Call to order: 6:40 p.m.

Show Chair Report

Meg informed the board that the judge for the October schooling show at Sundance Ranch in Redlands will be Lynda Lambert. Some tentative dates for the 2010 show season are March 7th location TBA, and May 2nd at Shadow Ridge.

It was moved to approve Meg permission to order additional ribbons for the ICC shows. Sheila 1st, Kathy Y. 2nd, all were in favor.

Newsletter/Website:

Cindy informed the board that the fees for sponsors and advertisements for the website/newsletter have been updated on the website and divided into two separate fee schedules to make it clearer for members.

Cindy will add to the main page of the website information for the October schooling show regarding costumes – costumes may be worn in any class as well as the costumed musical freestyle. Proper safety equipment required regardless of costume.

New Business:

The board members discussed the ongoing issue of whether or not to include non-ICC chapter members as eligible for ICC year-end chapter awards. At this time the board has decided to continue to operate as our standing rules are written which states that all CDS members are eligible.

Old Business:

The board members discussed whether to continue to donate to Rising Stars in Rancho Cucamonga. In the past ICC has used their facility (Rising Stars) in Rancho Cucamonga for shows and donated the rings fees to their organization. Due to concerns regarding footing ICC has decided not to hold any future shows at this location. The board would like to continue to donate to Rising Stars. Kathy Pavlich made a motion that Shadow Ridge will donate half of the ring fees from the May 2010 show to rising stars, Ruth 2nd. Each show will have to be evaluated individually and based on the amount of funds available.
