Donna took her first pony ride at age two and has been addicted to horses ever since. As a rider and trainer, she has twice represented the US in international competition, winning team gold at the 1999 Pan Am Games and team bronze at the 2001 Sydney, Australia CDI. With her popular horse Jazzman, she rode in the final selection trials for both the WEG and the World Cup. She is one of a handful of people to have earned all USDF regular and freestyle medals, as well as 17 CDS Horse of the Year Titles and 19 USDF National Championships, all on horses she has trained herself. A USEF "S" judge, she has judged competitions all over the United States as well as Canada and Mexico. Her students have also been successful, earning the NAYRC silver medal, the CDS Amateur Futurity Championship, CDS Intermediate II Horse of the Year, the CDS Fourth Level and Fourth Level Freestyle Amateur Horse of the Year, and the USDF Amateur Grand Prix Championship. Combining her expertise as an emergency physician with her riding and literary skills, Donna has written many articles for *Dressage Today*, *Practical Horseman*, and *Chronicle of the Horse*. She is especially concerned with helping middle aged and older equestrian athletes attain and maintain the physical fitness necessary to sustain their successful careers well into their later years. Donna is looking forward to a productive and fun 2011 Amateur Clinic series.

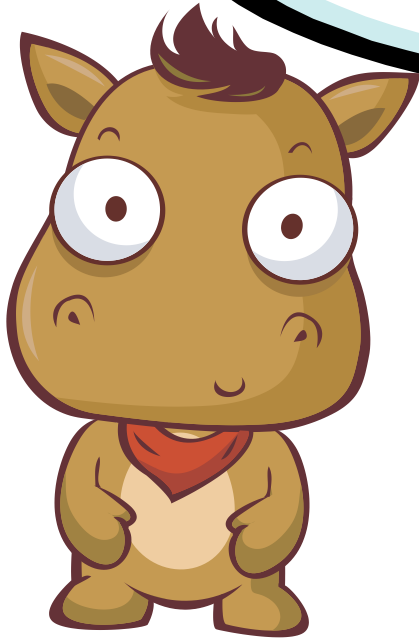
CDS Amateur Clinic selection protocol

- The Amateur clinics will be held annually in the Northern, Central and Southern Regions. Each region will have its own organizer.
- Amateur applications to the Amateur Clinics have first priority in the selection process. If additional riders are needed to fill the clinic, the regional organizer should choose these riders in the order in which the applications were received.
- After sufficient publicity early in the year, each Chapter Chair shall request that all interested members submit a written application to the chapter secretary.
- The Chapter Chair and one other Chapter Board Member should put the names in a hat and the rider be selected by a draw. An alternate rider should also be drawn. The rider(s) should be notified immedi-

ately as well as the regional organizer.

- Chapter Chairs / Treasurer should send a check for \$150 payable to CDS to the regional organizer made out to CDS. Opening date to receive checks is December 1. The selection rider is responsible for confirming that a check has been sent. If the Chapter does not send a check in time, the rider must send a personal check to secure a slot. All checks will be held until the clinic date.
- If the organizer does not receive the contribution from the Chapter or its rider in time, the clinic may be opened to other amateurs on the wait list who have submitted an application and a check for \$150.
- The present clinic format starts with a required introductory lecture session the evening prior to the first day of the clinic and two days of riding sessions.

How to Qualify for Jr. Championships:

A horse/rider combination must be a current member at the time scores are earned and must achieve the following for qualification at the various levels for the CDS Junior Championships. Qualifying dates run from cut-off date to cut-off date and the last day to qualify for Southern Jr. Championships is September 1st.

Training Level 3 scores of 62% or better with two different judges

First Level 3 scores of 60% or better with two different judges

Second Level 3 scores of 57% or better with two different judges

Third Level 3 scores of 57% or better with two different judges

Fourth Level 3 scores of 57% or better with two different judges

FEI /JR 3 scores of 57% or better with two different judges

FEI /YR 3 scores of 57% or better with two different judges

We would like to encourage all of the ICC Junior and Young Riders to try to try to qualify for the Jr. Championships. Good luck juniors and have a great show year in 2011!!!
